STEPS AFTER SELECTION

Medical examination No candidate will be permitted to join a course, unless declared medically fit by the Medical Board constituted by the Institute for the purpose. Joining

- 1. Anaesthesia for major cancer surgeries: thoracic, head and neck, Gastrointestinal / Genitourinary, neurosurgery orthopedic and microvascular free tissue transfer surgeries.
- 2. Regional Anaesthesia Technique: Including Spinal, Segmental Spinals, Field block, Epidural, Paravertebral, Brachial plexus, TAP Block, etc
- 3. Recent advances in Perioperative care of the cancer patient.
- 4. Difficult airway management, Fiberoptic intubation
- 5. PICC line and other central line insertions, Land Mark guided, USG Guided
- 6. Pain management : Acute and Cancer Pain
- 7. SICU
- 8. Palliative care.
