Fellowship course	Certificate course in Fellowship in Advance Reconstructive Microsurgery
Course Details	The course will be conducted at the BMCHRC and it will commence from January and July (each year). The fellowship course shall be a considered part of senior Residency. Since the total tenure of Senior Residency is 3 years. (including previous experience as SR the candidates are required to declare the period of training of service undertaken in other institution as Senior Resident at the time of applying .

Minimum eligibility criteria	Bonafide Indian Nationals, NRI and foreign candidate are eligible to apply <ul style="list-style-type: none">• MBBS Certificate• Mch/DNB or equivalent degree in plastic surgery• Must be recognized by the MCI/RMC at the time of joining• Post graduate qualifications from Department /institutions where MCI recognition has not been formally granted (for example: under consideration) will not be considered and candidature rejected at any stage.• Experience certificate• NOC (in case of currently employment) <u>Other documents</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Birth Certificate• Pan Card/Adhar Card• Passport size Photograph 1
Selection Criteria	Selection will be based on the evaluation of performance followed by interview.
Reservation	There is no reservation of seats for any category.

Application form fees	1000/- (One thousand Only). Candidates have to pay online payment. Once the application fee paid will not be refunded any circumstances.
Application Process	Interesting candidates fulfilling eligibility criteria should complete the application form as per instructions online. The hardcopy of application along with copies of all relevant certificates and documents are required to bring at the time of interview/admission. Application will be rejected if candidate provide incorrect /false information in the application form. No correspondence in this regard will be entertained.

Interview Scheduled Method of Selection	Every year in the Month of (April, November) Interview by selection committee <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Executive Director • Head –Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery • Dr Naresh Ledwani -Sr Consultant (Surgical Oncology)
Medical Examination and fitness	No candidate will be permitted to join a course, unless declared medically fit by the Medical Board constituted by the Institute for the purpose. The decision of the Board shall be final. With holding information about current or past illness/treatment/pregnancy status if discovered at a subsequent stage may result in appropriate disciplinary action.
Joining	If a candidate fails to join the course by the date stipulated in the selection letter, the offer shall automatically stand cancelled and the seat will be offered to candidates in the waiting list in the order of merit.
Duties and Responsibility	Student admitted to Fellowship Course in Plastic Surgery shall simultaneously work as Senior Residents. They will be required to perform such work as may be assigned to them and is necessary in the interest of patient care, teaching, training, research and in Emergency services as and when required. Leave will be entitled as per hospital policy.

After completion of course and passing the exit assessment a certificate of fellowship in advance reconstructive microsurgery will be issued by the institute.
