

Bhagwan Mahaveer Cancer Hospital and Research Centre (Managed by K G Kothari Memorial Trust) is accredited with National Board of Examination, (Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India) New Delhi for Post graduates courses in discipline of Surgical Oncology, Medical Oncology, Clinical Hematology, Radiation Oncology, Pathology, Palliative Medicine, NBEMS Diploma Course in Anesthesiology and Radio-diagnosis and FNB course in Onco Anesthesia. Every year 22 students (Medical, Surgical, Clinical Hematology, Radiation, Pathology, Palliative Medicine, Anesthesiology and Radio-Diagnosis) is register with the centre for doing their DNB/DrNB and FNB training courses.

Admission to DNB program is done by National Board of Examination, New Delhi through Centralized Entrance Test (CET). Following the details of seats available at Bhagwan Mahaveer Cancer Hospital & Research Centre.
